The Reform Temple of Rockland Funds

Adult & Family Education Fund: Jewish learning is *not* just for children! Jewish learning is for *families*. The purpose of this fund is to support hands-on educational programs for families of all ages. Adult and family programs are interactive and thought-provoking.

Beverly Gilbert Scholarship Fund: endowed to subsidize Jewish educational experiences of RTR children under the age of 18 who are in need of financial assistance.

<u>Building Fund</u>: general fund for RTR building improvement and beautification, including but not limited to, landscaping, hearing loop improvements, etc.

<u>Cantor Discretionary Fund</u>: used by the Cantor to add to the Temple's music library of books and recordings. Also offsets the cost of Temple music programs and supports national Jewish music organizations and other related charities. The monies in this fund are used solely at the discretion of the Cantor to assist individual, educational and communal needs as the Cantor shall deem necessary or appropriate.

<u>Chesed</u>: This fund helps provide shiva meals, cards/flowers for hospital, etc. to those in need

<u>Family in Crisis Fund</u>: assistance for RTR members, relatives, other religious organizations and/or community at large that have come into dire financial circumstances.

<u>Library Fund (Rose & Moe Aranow Memorial Fund:</u> purchase books for Temple library. These books are available to RTR Temple members.

<u>Morton Troy Educational Enrichment Fund</u>: provides funding for special programs at the RTR religious school.

<u>Music Fund (Cantor George Weinflash Memorial)</u>: bringing outside music programs, guest musicians and special choir programs to RTR.

<u>Oneg Fund</u>: provides Onegs and Kiddushim for services not sponsored by individual families.

Prayer Book & Bible Fund (Phyllis & Morton Simon Memorial): purchase prayer books or Bible commentary.

<u>Rabbi's Discretionary Fund</u>: used solely at the discretion of the Rabbi to assist individual, educational and communal needs as the Rabbi shall deem necessary or appropriate.

Rabbi Louis Frishman Youth Endowment Fund: provides funds for Youth Programs and Youth Group activities.

<u>Sylvia and Hyman Rosenzweig Scholarship Fund</u>: subsidizes the endeavors of promising young people who engage in programs to deepen their knowledge of Judaism.

<u>Social Action (Karen Ami) Fund</u>: donations via RTR religious school or otherwise to be used for various charitable causes.

<u>Youth Fund</u>: general and special RTR youth programs, including youth group activities and special post B'nai Mitzvah programs designed to keep those youth engaged
